## What is Reach?

Reach is a ministry of Bethesda Free Church, Sunderland. It was created to train and equip young people in the three important aspects of the Great Commission; Evangelism, Discipleship and Missions.

The training material we use has been developed by Bethesda staff.

## Who is it for?

Reach is for believers who are actively involved in a local evangelical church.

## What should I expect?

- Evangelism You will receive practical training on how to work up a conversation with strangers, change conversations into spiritual ones and how to explain the gospel simply and biblically to people from all walks of life.
- **Discipleship** You will see how you can be involved investing in other believers as they grow in their faith and the importance of commitment to the local church.
- Missions You will learn about you and your church's responsibility toward foreign missions whether God calls you to stay or to go.
- Fellowship You will meet others who are excited about sharing their faith and who want to walk with and live for Christ

By the end of the week we hope that you will have grown in your walk with God, made friends who will encourage you to keep living for Christ and you will have the confidence to share your faith.

### When is it?

Reach will start on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> August at Noon and will end on Saturday 18th August at 2pm. However, if you need to come before or leave after, we can arrange this with you.

### How much is it?

Reach is free. This includes food and accommodation. This does not include your travel expenses.

If you are interested in coming, speak to your pastor and fill in the forms included.

Dear Pastor/Parent,

Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, we trust that this letter finds you blessed with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Him.

We at Bethesda Free Church are hosting Reach18; an evangelistic training week for young people on our church premises between Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> August. We have been hosting this event for over five years.

The young people will stay at the church for the duration of the week. Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided.

- In the mornings there will be two hour class sessions where the young people will be taught the principles of sharing their faith.
- After lunch, under responsible leadership, they will be taken out into the city of Sunderland to practice sharing the gospel and handing out gospel literature.
- In the evenings there will be services dealing with the theme of foreign missions and evening devotions on what it means to be a godly man or woman.

The training material used has been created by Bethesda staff with the purpose of equipping believers to share their faith, disciple others and get involved in foreign missions at home.

There is no cost to the week except for the travelling expenses to and from Sunderland. Bethesda Free Church will cover the food and accommodation costs.
